Phone Numbers

- Camp phone / FAX

Food Service

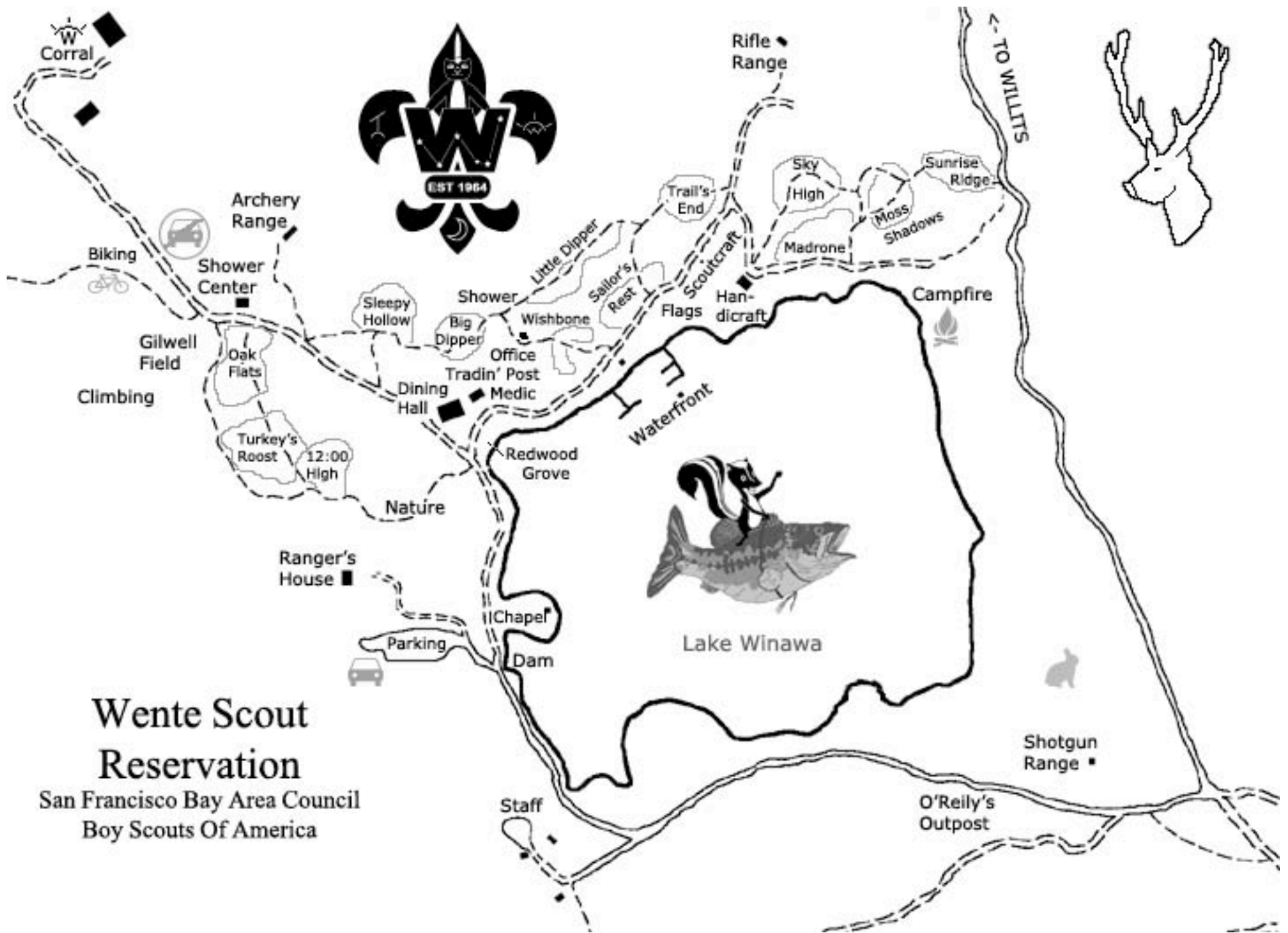
- All meals included

Early Release

- Special permission required
 - Section C on Medical Form
- Day of departure
 - Check in at Camp Office
 - Show ID to match form
 - Staff will find your son
 - Check out with Scoutmaster
 - Check out with Camp Office



Medical Forms

- New form this year
 - Part A & C: parent fills out
 - Part B: doctor fills out, signature *required*
 - Attach copy of medical insurance card
- Keep original
 - Good for one year
 - Give Scoutmaster Dave a photocopy

Medications

- Prescription drugs
 - Must be checked with camp medic
 - List on medical form
 - Exceptions:
 - Life threatening conditions
 - Inhalers
- Scouts keep non-prescription meds

Trading Post

- Al Robinson Trading Post
 - Sweets, sodas, Gatorade
 - Merit badge extras
 - Souvenirs
- Camp Bank
 - Deposit funds at departure -- small bills
 - Scout can withdraw as needed
 - Unused money returned on the way home
 - After Dave stops by Coyote Valley Casino :-)

- Meet at BMS at 8:00 am
 - Wear Class-A uniform
 - Bathing suit underneath
- Check-in with Scoutmaster Dave
 - Final forms & medication check
 - Camp Bank deposits
 - Keep \$\$ for lunch!
 - Driver assignment
- Depart at 8:30 sharp!
 - Lunch at Burger King in Willits

Return Day -- July 11th

- Pack up camp
 - Return Camp Bank funds to boys
 - Pass check-out inspection
 - Depart 9:00ish -- if we're lucky
- Drive home
 - Scouts will be dropped off at home
 - Probably early afternoon
 - In-N-Out tradition!
